How to get to Madrid

How to get to Madrid from Barajas International Airport

After passing through passport control and collecting your baggage, exit the terminal where you will see signs for "Metro", bus and taxis.

You can reach Madrid by

a) Metro/subway. Follow the signs "Metro" and take it to the closest station to your accommodation. It will cost you less than 3,00€. If you arrive at Terminal 1 or 2, just follow the signs "Metro" to the station named "Aeropuerto". If you arrive at Terminal 4, follow the signs to "Aeropuerto T4".

All addresses (families, student rooms, apartments and hotels) will have the closest metro station included. It can be tiring if you have heavy luggage.

Take the "Metro" to Nuevos Ministerios station and then a taxi to your accommodation. It should not cost more than 20,00€ in any case. Metro de Madrid www.metromadrid.es

b) Bus. "AIRPORT EXPRESS" yellow bus 24H from terminals T1, T2 and T4 to Plaza de Cibeles in the very center of Madrid, there is an intermediate stop at calle O'Donnell corner with calle Doctor Esquerdo. From 6:00 to 23:30 also stops at Atocha-Renfe railway station. Price 2012 is 2 €.

200 blue bus from terminals T1, T2 and T4 to intercambiador Avenida de América from 5:10 to 23:30. Price 2012 is 2 €.

c) Taxi. You can take a taxi from the airport. **Pay no attention to the "taxi-drivers" who approach you inside the terminal, and follow the signs "taxi".**

All Madrid's taxis are white with a red stripe and a licence number on the door. Under normal traffic conditions, a taxi should not cost you more than 40,00€ in any case, including airport supplement 5,50€. From Terminal 4 add 4 or 5€ more. You can demand an official receipt. Prices are printed in the window of the taxi. Should you have any problem, take the licence number of the taxi and inform Estudio Sampere office the following day.

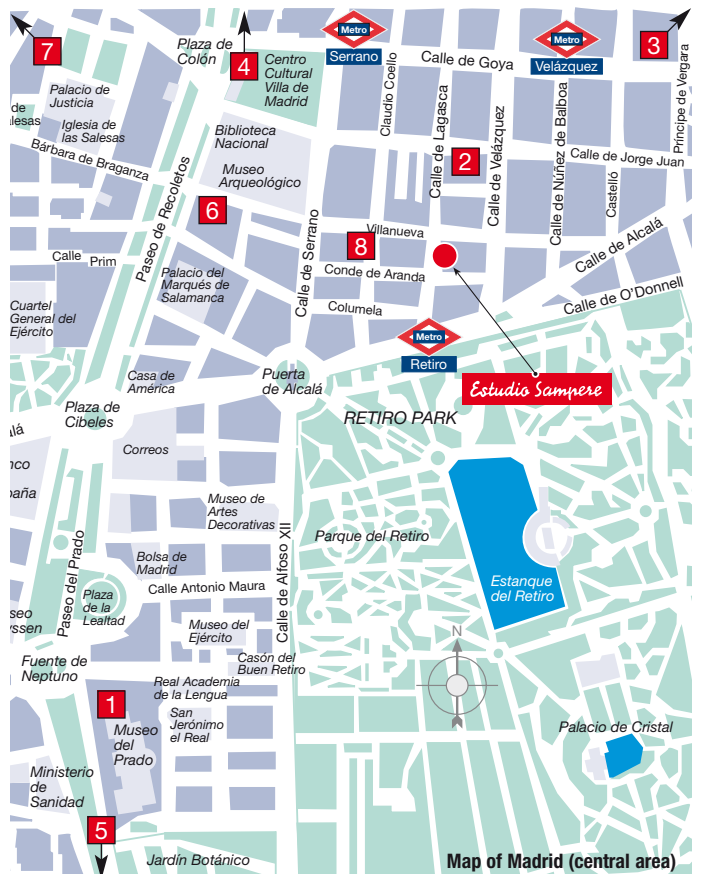
